

Reflection: In today's gospel we meet a God who reaches out to everyone – even the 'unclean' and the rejected. Jesus had a unique way of accepting and welcoming everyone who came to him. He looked for, and he saw, not wealth or poverty, Jew of Samaritan, clean and unclean, but the image of God dwelling within us since the beginning of creation.

Remember, at the Last Supper, Jesus washed his disciples' feet, and he said to them, "I leave you an example, so that you should do what I have done to you." Today, we must hear Jesus say the same to us.
