Reflection: Today's Gospel talks about, "Nation fighting against Nation, Kingdom against Kingdom?". Is this what we are presently experiencing in our world?

This week, at the COP27 in Egypt, we are hearing terribly dire warnings from World leaders about climate change and the, nearly, unrecoverable damage we are doing to our planet. One is immediately struck by the starkness of the opening address of the Secretary General of the United Nations:

"We are in the fight of our lives, and we are losing. Global temperatures keep rising. We are on a highway to climate hell with our foot still on the accelerator." He concluded his opening remarks with these words:

"Humanity has a choice: cooperate or perish. It is either a Climate Solidarity Pact – or a Collective Suicide Pact."

"Our Father created such a beautiful world, only for us to destroy it. I hope world leaders see the importance of tackling climate change soon". Pope Francis
