Speaker: Prof. Pierce Grace.

Topic: *Six Doctors, One Hospital (Medicine in Limerick)*

Venue: Christchurch Methodist Hall, O'Connell Street, Limerick Eircode V94 W275 (near White House pub).

Professor Grace is a retired consultant general and vascular surgeon at UL Hospitals, Limerick (1996-2014). He is an Associate Fellow in the Department of History at the University of Limerick, Ireland.

In his lecture, he is going to speak about the history of medicine in Limerick through the lives and experiences of six Limerick doctors ranging from the fifteenth to the twenty-first centuries and will discuss how the hospital system in Limerick evolved from the eighteenth to its current disposition.

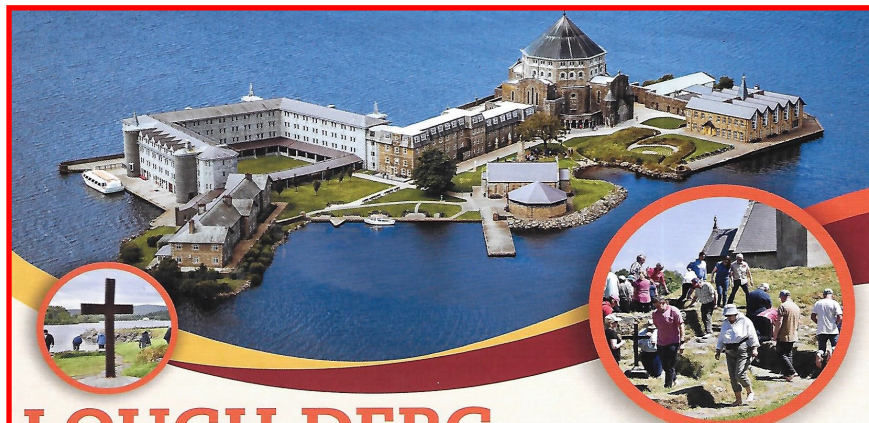
