SUNDAY REFLECTION - A God Who is very Close

The message coming loud and clear through today readings is that our God is not far away, that he is not “up there somewhere”, a kind of scary, long-bearded policeman in the sky. The message coming through is that our God is close by and he cares. In the First Reading (from Exodus) Moses is told that God is the “Lord, a God of tenderness and compassion, slow to anger, rich in kindness and faithfulness”. We really need to hear that and to become utterly convinced of it especially when we find times rough and painful.
