<u>Reflection</u> What is the Feast of Corpus Christi?

The Latin "Corpus Christi" translates to "Body of Christ" in English. Traditionally known as the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, Corpus Christi celebrates the gift of the Eucharist. Harkening back to the Feeding of the Five Thousand, the Wedding at Cana, and the Last

Supper, this special day commemorates that with Jesus' Resurrection and Ascension into Heaven,

He is always present with us, fully alive in the Eucharist.
