SUNDAY REFLECTION - The Body and Blood of Christ – Corpus Christi

What then does Jesus mean? We are to eat his flesh and drink his blood in the sense that we are to appropriate, to assimilate totally into our very being all that he teaches, his vision, his values, his understanding of the meaning and purpose of life. We are to be able to say, with Paul, "I live, not I, but Christ lives in me" (Galatians 2:20). Or elsewhere, "Let this mind be in you which was in Christ Jesus" (Philippians 2:5). His thinking is our thinking, his dreams are our dreams... This is the basic and fundamental meaning of eating the body and blood of Christ: total union with him in our way of thinking and living.
