Pope Francis compared the Nativity scene to a well from which we can draw the nearness of God, "the source of hope and joy."

The Nativity scene, he said, "is like a living Gospel, a domestic Gospel," And like the well in the Bible, the Nativity scene "is a place of encounter where, we bring to Jesus the expectations and worries of life, just as the shepherds of Bethlehem and the people of Greccio did."

And if, the Pope said, when we stand before the Nativity scene, "we entrust to Jesus all we hold dear, we too will experience 'great joy'."
