While Pope Francis has declared this Synodal Assembly "completed," the Final Document emphasises that a crucial implementation phase lies ahead. This next stage will focus on integrating Synodality as a "constitutive dimension of the Church."

The text also addresses accountability measures, calling for enhanced financial transparency and protocols for abuse prevention, declaring: "The need within the Church for healing, reconciliation and the rebuilding of trust has resounded at every stage of the synodal process."

**Background**

The Final Document represents the culmination of one of the most extensive consultative processes in Church history, building on both the 2023 assembly's work and the broader Synodal journey initiated by Pope Francis in 2021.
