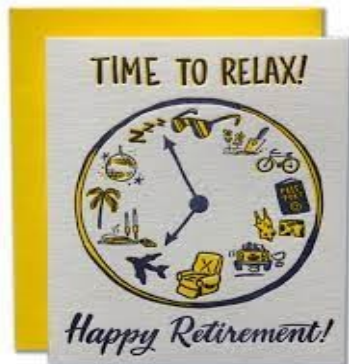


Parish Newsletter Sunday 10th September 2023
