

Reflection : When Jesus said, *"I no longer call you servants, I call you friends..."* he meant it. He qualifies to relate to us as friend and we qualify to relate to him as friend because we, like Jesus, were born into the same world; we walk the same roads; we breathe the same air, and we experience the joys and sorrows of human life and death together.



And when he said, that *"I am with you always, to the end of time."* He meant that too. We are truly never alone, even when we don't see it. Jesus calls us 'friend' because we are truly worthy of his friendship, even when we don't feel we are. Jesus always forgives us and never judges or condemns us because he knows what we go through, and he understands our frailties and weaknesses because he shared all of them with us. What else does Jesus teach us? Simple! Avoid getting into narrow, black and white, right or wrong, arguments with anyone. See beyond the detail to the meaning. Search for the life and joy and peace which is always present in that which is of God.

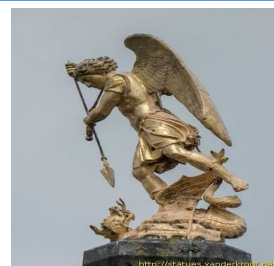


Limerick Historical Society (Ireland)
