Diocesan Needs Collection

As we approach the next Diocesan Needs Collection we thought we would give a little insight into what this collection is used for. This collection is used to fund the different diocesan initiatives. They provide resources for parish training for Eucharist Ministers and Pastoral Units. They also provide Youth Ministry in the areas of Pilgrimages, Muintearas Íosa, Anois Youth Leadership programme etc. It also provides financial support to the Limerick Diocesan Centre. The principal activities of this office are to host the Bishop's office, Primary Schools Religious Education Office, support services for Parishes/Priests. It also provides education and sup-port for student priests with clerical studies for the Diocese.

St John's Parish currently contribute €15,573.96 in Annual Diocesan Levy. In 2018 the Diocesan Needs Collection amounted to €11,979.97. This left a shortfall of €3594.01. This shortfall had to be paid from parish funds. We wish to thank you for your continuous support for this collection going forward and we would hope to come close to meeting the levy in 2019 with your help. Once again many thanks for your continued support. The Diocesan needs collection will take place next weekend.


Culture Night 2019
