A particularly moving and unexpected highlight was getting to see Pope Francis as he appeared briefly at the Gemelli hospital before being discharged from hospital. The group also visited the Irish College with Limerick Diocesan priest, Fr. Paul Finnerty is rector. Blessed with good weather, the pilgrims visited many of the famous sites of Rome, including the catacombs and the church that houses the famous Icon of Our Lady of Perpetual Help.
