Eucharistic Adoration takes place in the Cathedral each Friday from 3.30pm to 5.30pm.


Cathedral Shop

Reflection: John the Baptist was the one sent to prepare the way for the Messiah. As Jesus tells us today, John was the "greatest of the Prophets." The God who comes among us on Christmas morning; the God who lies in the crib as a helpless child, is the God revealed to us by the life and words of Jesus, and only of Jesus. They are words of forgiveness, of welcome, of love and peace and joy and friendship.

It is why we celebrate at Christmas – because our God is so close, so wonderful, so much greater than any words we can imagine. To the God of Jesus, we are friends, not servants. God's Kingdom, for Jesus, is a place of welcome, where all are invited to enter, not a place of reward and punishment where entry is for the chosen few.
