Reflection FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING

The final scene of today's Gospel is a wonderful mix of the majestic and the ordinary. It begins with a majestic court scene. The basis on which judgment is delivered is ordinary acts of kindness to the needy and the vulnerable. They are not heroic but they demand attention and clear vision. Two saints have summed up the judgment scene quite simply. St Anthony the Great, the founder of the monastic movement in Egypt in the third century, reminded his monks "virtue is not far from us. It is not outside of ourselves but it lies within us, and it is easy, if only we are willing." St John of the Cross put it even more simply: "in the evening of life, we shall be judged on love."
