

Autumn Dues Collection

The Autumn Dues collection will take place next weekend the 26th/27th October. The Dues Collection is taken up for the income for the priests. The priests receive a modest salary. They use their salary for day to day living and while they have accommodation they are subject to normal living costs, heat, light, food, maintaining and running a car, just like every household. The Dues Collection is needed to support two full time priests and one part time. The annual income from the Dues Collections, for 2018 was €22,500, this does not cover the total amount for salaries and therefore we have to supplement it from other parish resources. While we bring this to your attention we very much appreciate your continuing support and generosity. Envelopes are available at the door of the Cathedral. Please take one and return it next weekend or at your convenience.
