Diocesan Needs Collection


The Diocesan Needs Collection takes place this weekend.

Culture Night Organ Concert

Peter Barley is pleased to be returning to play the fine Hill organ in St John's Cathedral for a special Limerick Pipe Organ Festival Culture Night concert on Friday 20th September from 7:00pm to 7:30pm. Peter is Organist and Choir Master in neighbouring St Mary's Cathedral. Admission Free.

Limerick Pipe Organ Festival was founded in 2014, as part of Limerick's year as City of Culture, under the auspices of the Roman Catholic Diocese to celebrate the 150th birthday of the St John's Cathedral organ. The concert programme, which is designed to suit the strengths of both the mighty organ and this beautiful cathedral with its splendidly reverberant acoustic, will feature music by J.S. Bach, Guilmant and Mozart. The Bach is a delightfully youthful Prelude and Fugue, whilst the


music by Mozart ranges from a majestic Adagio and Fugue to a sprightly pair of Epistle Sonatas. The half-hour recital will conclude with Guilmant's stirring and skilful March on a theme of Handel, which listeners will recognize as being the opening of the chorus 'Lift up your heads' from Handel's Messiah. The concert will be preceded by a guided tour of the cathedral from 6:30pm to 7:00pm.
