Also people pray to her for lost keys.

Summary: St Zita, Many miracles are associated both during her lifetime and for those who have had recourse to her after she died. She is specially honoured in the Basilica of St Frediano (reputedly an Irish saint, possibly could be Finiano) in Lucca in northern Italy. Zita was generous to a fault. She shared her own food. Zita's body was found, whole and entire, and it is kept with great respect richly enshrined in St. Frediano's Church in Lucca, Italy.

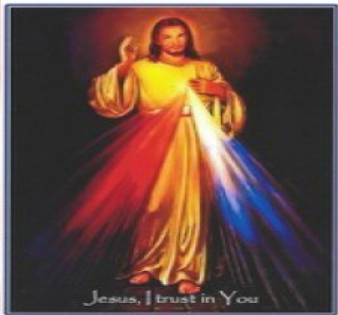
