The Pope made the appeal to put the celebration of the Eucharist at the centre of our lives, Pope Francis, "if you are the same at the end of Mass, as you were at the beginning, something is wrong."

In his new prayer intention, the Holy Father invites us to see the celebration of the Eucharist not as an obligatory ritual, but rather as an encounter with the Risen Jesus, for "the Eucharist is the presence of Jesus," which is "profoundly transforming." It is Christ Who offers Himself, Who gives Himself for us," which leads to "our lives being nourished by Him, to nourish the lives of our brothers and sisters."
