CHANGE TO SUNDAY MASS SCHEDULE


As and <u>from Next Sunday the 6th of March</u> there will be no evening mass at 7.00pm.

Reflection: The ancient Greek philosopher, Socrates, tells us that self-knowledge is the beginning of wisdom. Few of us are truly wise in this respect. We're so focused on the faults of others – those with whom we work and those for whom we work, the members of our community or family, our leaders – that we have little time or energy for the most fundamental and important exercise of all: truly looking at ourselves and correcting our own faults. In today's gospel Jesus challenges us to refocus our sharp analytical skills, so quick to diagnose the faults and failings of others, and centre them on ourselves. He is asking us to put our own house in order before trying to reform others. This is surely an appropriate invitation to all of us as we are about to begin the Holy season of Lent.

This Lent, Trócaire will provide vital help to Thandekile and her family and to many more like them as they strive to create better futures for their families.
