Liturgy Corner

The Liturgical Season of Lent has begun and this weekend we celebrate the Second Sunday of Lent. Lent lasts for 40 days, if you don't count the Sundays, until sunset on Holy Thursday. During Lent, the Church gives us some ideas as to how we can grow in our calling as Christians, Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving, these are the three things we can work on especially during the Lenten season.

Bishop Brendan in his letter last weekend focused on Prayer and Lent is indeed a time of prayer, an invitation to spend more time each day in conversation with the God who loves us. Set aside 5, 10, 15 or more minutes each day during Lent for prayer to come even closer to Jesus Christ who himself always made time for prayer.

It is also a time to fast. To the fasts of Ash Wednesday and Good Friday we can add our own act of giving up something we enjoy, and remember it doesn't have to be food, and join our sacrifices to the sacrifice of Christ by which we are saved.

Lent is as well a time for almsgiving. We can see Lent as a time to begin or renew our compassion for those who are hungry, sick, lonely, or otherwise in need. We can help others experience God's unconditional love through our own generosity.

Don't try to do too much, keep it simple and doable. We are invited to live our entire lives growing closer to God. Don't try to pack it all into one Lent. Lent is a liturgical and spiritual journey to the foot of the Cross on Good Friday, as we seek Jesus out, ask his help, join in his suffering, and learn to live and love like him.
